

TRANSFER STUDENT CHECKLIST

Submit a Transfer Application

Submit your application online at ohio.edu/admissions/transfer/apply.

Request Transcript(s) from Prior Institution(s)

Have official transcripts sent directly from each college or university you have attended. If you have completed fewer than 20 college level semester hours or 30 college level quarter hours at a regionally accredited institution post-high school, you will need your high school to send an official high school transcript.

Visit Campus (optional)

Activate Your OHIO ID (mandatory)

Shortly after applying to OHIO, you will receive a letter containing your PID and instructions for activating your account. You will need to activate your account to check your application status, submit your housing contract or conduct other online transactions with OHIO. Please retain both your PID and OHIO ID for continued access to the online systems and your accounts.

Check Application Status

Review Your Transfer Evaluation Report

Soon after your admission, you will receive a credit evaluation report and accompanying documents available through your MyOHIO Student Center. Complete the FAFSA (strongly recommended)

Complete and submit the FAFSA as soon as possible for need-based financial aid consideration. You can submit the FAFSA online at fafsa.gov. Our code is 003100.

Submitting Your Housing Contract (if appropriate)

Transfer students under the age of 22 who cannot demonstrate two full years in attendance at an institution of higher education after high school graduation must reside in Ohio University-owned housing and participate in the associated meal plan. Registering for Transfer Orientation (mandatory)

Send Final Transcripts
